- ✓ Tick the grey boxes on the right hand side that apply to you (e.g. whole school, plus your child's class, but not staff)
- ✓ Once you have ticked these, go back and click the menu button on the left hand corner. Click 'Inbox' and now you are ready to receive notifications

If you have already downloaded the app last year, you will need to tick on your child's new class to be able to receive notifications.

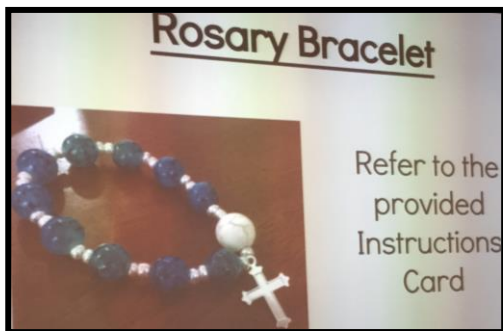
### DISABLED CARPARKS

## REPORT EXAMPLE

This is **an example** of how the Target Skills are presented in the mid-year reports for a **Year 1 student**.

For this student, we can see that the skill that needs the most practice is *retelling the main events of a story*.

The skills listed in the Developing column, requires consistent practice to consolidate them.

*Using punctuation to support fluency and phrasing* is independently demonstrated at this level.
