



Cyber Safety at COHR

We surveyed our students from Yr 3 - 6 about what devices they use at home and how long they are on these devices. We also asked what apps/websites/games they use and how long they would visit them. After sharing the results with the Education Board, we thought it was important to share them with our parent body. It is a concern that we have students using some apps that require them to be 13+. Next week we will share what our students use these apps/websites/games for and who they are interacting with and their understanding of the privacy settings.
