EDUCATION BOARD

During last week's Education Board meeting the fee structure for next year was approved. Next year's fees will be as follows:

<u>Annual Tuition Fee:</u>	1 child	\$1485
	2 children	\$1920
	3+ children	\$2050

Annual Capital Fee: **\$210 per family**

Maintenance Fee: **\$50 per family**

As with this year, there are no rebates for families attending Working Bees

Subject Levy: **\$215 per child** (which includes a Technology Levy of \$50)

Excursion Levy: **\$65 per child**

Interschool Sport: **\$45 (Year 5/6)**

This will cover the Friday morning inter schools, but not other sports events – for example a team progressing into regionals.

Book Levy: **\$40 per child**

Camp Yr 5/6: **\$500** (Year 5/6 students – approx. to be confirmed)

Camp Yr 4: **\$160** (Year 4 students – approx. to be confirmed)
