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


## Save the Date

Our school is about to launch a Book Fair on Friday 3rd May until Friday 10th May. We would love to see you there.

We are hosting a LAMONT BOOK FAIR. Each grade in the school will preview the books during their library session in week two of this term. The preview sessions are an ideal opportunity for children to share and discuss the books with their teachers and peers. Students will bring home a wish list to discuss with you. Our 5/6 classes will preview on Monday of week three after they return from camp.

The selection of books at our Book Fair will include a wide range of quality books from the best Australian and overseas authors and illustrators. Our school benefits by receiving generous commission in the form of books to add to the library resources.

Parents are also welcome to come and view the books before or after school. Parent viewing will begin from the morning of FRIDAY 3rd May, so that ALL children have had a look and a discussion at home first! The following are times for parents to come and view.
